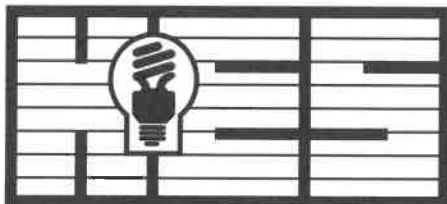

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Hopkinsville Electric System will award two (2) \$2,000 scholarships. HES Scholarship Applicants must meet the qualifications listed below.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must:

- Have a primary residence with a Hopkinsville Electric System residential electric account number.
- Be accepted as a fulltime student at an accredited two- or four-year college, university or vocational/technical school.
- Have at least a minimum GPA of 3.0 out of at least a 4.0 GPA scale.

Application Instructions:

- Type or print.
- Complete the scholarship application in full. **IF ANY INFORMATION IS INCOMPLETE, THE APPLICATION WILL BE REJECTED.**
- Prepare a 300-word essay describing your career goals and how your achievement of these goals will improve your quality of life.
- Submit two (2) letters of recommendation.
- All signatures must be provided where indicated on the application.

Terms and Conditions:

- Two (2) \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded from the Hopkinsville Electric System service area to students graduating from high school in spring 2018 and who are enrolled in higher education for the fall 2018.
- All applications will be awarded on a one-time basis and will not be renewable.
- Scholarships will be paid upon proof of registration (i.e. Class Schedule) at an institute of higher education and will be issued in July to the student.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified no later than July 1, 2018.
- Scholarships will be awarded without regard to race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, gender or disability.
- Applicants are not eligible for a scholarship if you are an employee or director of HES/EnergyNet, or a member of the immediate family (defined as spouse, parent, child, grandchild, sibling, regardless of where resided); or resident of the same household of any of the above persons (whether or not related).
